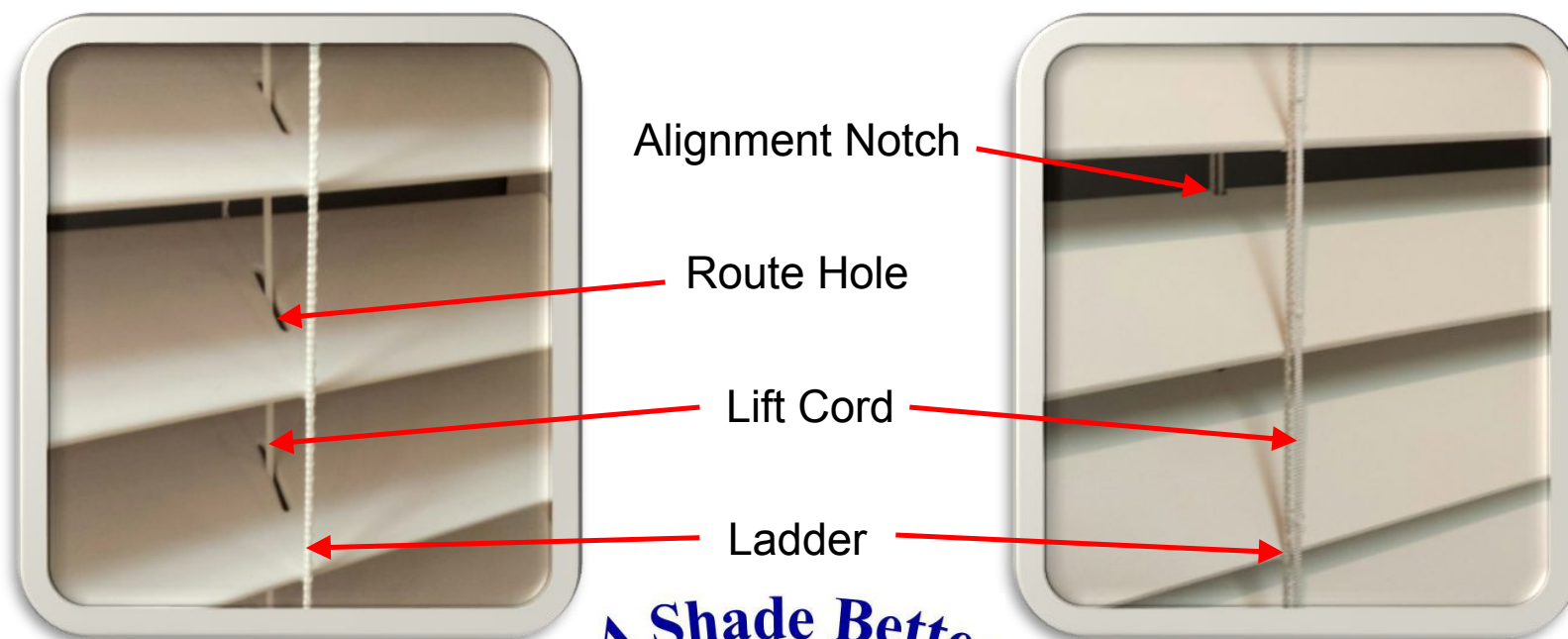


Routeless vs. Routed Blinds

Routeless blinds are regular blinds with a no-hole design. Routeless blinds function like any other blind, but less light gets through because the route holes have been eliminated and the lift cord that used to run through the route holes has been moved. Routeless blinds run the lift cords along the outside of the ladder cord, almost unseen. Routeless blinds reduce both the light and privacy gap associated with standard “routed” blinds by allowing the slats to close tighter, one touching another. An additional benefit of routeless blinds is the slats can be easily removed for cleaning - without having to disassemble the blind. Routeless blinds are not recommended for doors.
